Recent Projects

1. In several cross-border disputes involving more than 50 boxes of printed documents, Litigation Edge consultants provided digitisation and coding services for ingestion into a hosted document review platform. This enabled teams in located in different countries to review the evidence and collaborate with clients in a cost efficient and timely manner.
2. In an employment dispute involving a Singapore company with operations in the PRC, Litigation Edge provided a platform for parties to review email evidence collected from a former employee's personal computer. We deployed a leading first pass review platform to enable our clients to review emails in multiple languages (English and Chinese).

3. We were engaged by a global pharmaceutical company to provide data collection involving 4 live production servers and external storage devices. Deploying cutting-edge remote collection technology, we were able to extract 6 terabytes of data via the LAN, without taking down the servers for imaging.

We were engaged by a Singapore law firm to assist in the drafting of an e-discovery protocol in a cross-border commercial dispute involving identification and collection of emails residing in remote email servers. Remote data collection activities will follow finalisation of the e-discovery protocol.

Digitisation

Brad Mixner is appointed to Litigation Edge's Board of Directors

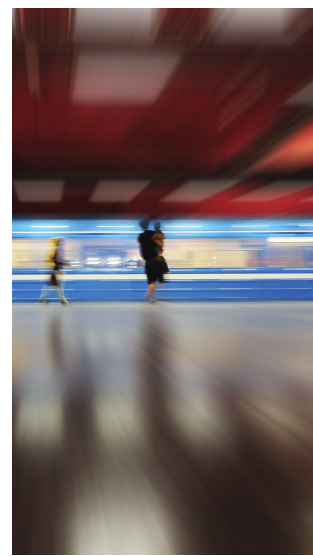
